

# Important Information About Your Drinking Water

## Port of the Islands Drinking Water System

### SITUATION

Port of the Islands public drinking water system failed to perform annual compliance Monitoring for the Synthetic Organic Contaminants, during the year of 2024 in accordance with Rule 62-550.514, Florida Administrative Code, and our current, Department approved, sampling plan.

### HEALTH EFFECTS

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During 2024, we did not perform quarterly monitoring for Synthetic Organic Contaminants, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water (with respect to these contaminants) during that time.*

### WHAT SHOULD CUSTOMERS DO?

Samples for these contaminants were collected in May 2024, and the laboratory analyses results indicated that our water system was meeting drinking water standards therefore,

**at this time, customers need not take any action or seek an alternate water supply.**

### WHAT IS BEING DONE ?

Although our water system did not perform quarterly monitoring for Synthetic Organic Contaminants during 2024, we did collect samples for these contaminants in May 2024; our water system will begin quarterly monitoring in accordance with our Department approved sampling plan.
